# **Meeting Summary**

#### I. Issues Discussion

- 1. Funding opportunities: County is sending out open space & farmland application to committee. Hope to get approved this week (goal). accelerated schedule because year for NYS AG farmland funding with due date in July talk advantage of matching funding. Hope to align funding. Applications due May 25th anticipated due date. County is available to assist resolutions, mapping. Available on website, PLAN can post, OSI can post on website. County will reach out directly to municipal staff. Trails will be out next. \$100,000 OS and farmland. \$50,000 for trails.
- 2. Community forest projects -\$500,000 in governor's proposed budget OSI and PLAN discussing opportunities to be a demonstration county. Town of Greenfield project adjacent to Lincoln Mtn state forest. Community forest managed by a community (muni or land trust) forest resource management educational, teach sustainable forests management, programming, trails, recreational programming. Not many in NYS. Rensselaer Plateau Alliance example the best example. Town of Wells (5,000acres) snowmobile corridor, hunting, fishing, turn profit from timber sales.

- II. 2018 Goals for the County Board of Supervisors Trail Committee This list of goals, once consensus is reached by this committee, will be forwarded to the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors Trail Committee for consideration.
  - 1. Zim Smith final title Mechanicville School district bus garage parking lot access to school and trail. Bus garage over budget but may just move ahead. final stages of ROW acquisitions.
    - i. Connecting the Zim Smith to the Champlain Canalway Trail (CCT)
      - 1. Planning for connection from Mechanicville to CCT
    - ii. Coons Crossing to Mechanicville connection complete ongoing project ongoing. Ongoing activities include: approaching land owners, out to bid in 2-3 months, construction starting early summer, CP rail crossing discussions, working with school district, and parking lot construction in Round Lake.

- iii. Oak street to Spa State Park connection Explore opportunity to extend from terminus at Oak Street north to Spa State Park. Where is state parks involved in this discussion? They should be at the table. DEC and State Parks has been involved in regular conversations. Jackie to send relevant discussion items from the Committee to State Parks moving forward. Katie to identify appropriate contact for that sharing of information.
- iv. Mechanicville to CCT signage/ street markings
- v. City trail near Woods Hollow to connect Milton, Ballston Spa, and Saratoga Springs/future Zim Smith trail
- vi. Segment between Village of Ballston Spa snow dump and County sewer ROW in Malta

## 2. Champlain Canalway Projects

- i. Complete the trail through Waterford and Halfmoon to Rt 4 near the treatment plant just south of Mechanicville;
- ii. Stone dust on the trail in the Town of Saratoga from near the sword surrender site south to near Garnsey Lane

#### 3. Equine trails

- i. Moreau County Forest and Providence equine trail improvements
  - 1. Providence –complete the trail systems with signage, trail marking, and a kiosk. This would complete 9 miles of trails including Packer Rd.
  - 2. Moreau complete parking lot; connect to County Forest Land and connect north to OSI piece connects to park along river.
  - 3. Town of Moreau bike path plan connect to property OSI property

# 4. Palmertown regional trail system

- i. Extend Northern Terminus in Palmertown area
- ii. Participate in Master Planning Process public meeting and survey conducted to date, stakeholder interviews conducted muni and major interest groups.
  Developing recommendations in June/July. 1000 ft elevation gain ridge line.
  Still largely undeveloped. Moreau lake state park is in middle of the ridge.
  Moreau at north and spa state park at south. Connect via trail system 1st phase is to create a spine trail and side trails to connect. Opportunity for different groups mtn biking, horseback, etc. id sensitive areas, forest products industries, etc.
- iii. Lincoln State Forest equine use allowed but trails not developed. Mtn biking, snowmobile corridor, what communities want to be connected: Corinth or Wilton access? How to expand recreational opportunities.

## 5. Blueway Trails

- i. Support of designation of Kaydeross between Kelley Park and Saratoga Lake as Blueway Trail ask Blue Neils where we are. Jason to follow-up with Blue.
- ii. Erie-Mohawk Historic Water Trail?

# III. Localized Goals of Trails Committee for 2018

1. Boyhaven (Milton) - development of trails and connections to Moreau State Forest - waiting on contract with anonymous donor - at town attorney, environmental soil samples (clean), comptroller working on bond and hope to close April 2018 (anticipated). TB will

need to decide if they keep ownership or turn portion over to DEC. DEC has expressed willingness to buy. Strong support in the town for this effort.

- 2. Corinth trail system Linking the towns of Wilton see extended from Moreau Lake State Park across Corinth to state land/spruce mountain, Corinth reservoir property. willing to present to town board if discuss snowmobiles and coordinate with mtn bike. Include trail easement/access in subdivision process. State land land-locked in town of Corinth similar to spruce mountain approach., black pond lean to? Easement lands a challenge certain rights land owners still have (private leases and rights associated with those parcels). Snowmobile club must be done by March 31 with activity challenge and limited window to allow snowmobile access. May requirement recreational management plan amendment (DEC has a management plan in additions to the IUP). DEC adventure N Y program focusing on underserved communities and access. Opportunity to make recreational connection to larger Palmertown region. Palmertown master plan includes recreation. Bill to work with Katie and County to identify potential route. Incorporate into the Palmertown master plan to support. Birth of American tourism, book.
- 3. Extend the Ballston Bike Path to Blue Barnes Road
- 4. Saratoga Springs Greenbelt system Downtown connector follow up with Tina Carton. Portion of Route 9 is 6-8 ft shoulder owned by state that portion looks to be ready to go.

  - 10. Tunnel/bridge over/under I87 to connect Spring Run Trail to E side of I87

  - 14. Route 9 bikeway Saratoga Springs to Glens Falls and Route 50 mistakenly marked years ago and no intention of stenciling and marking in the future (DOT). This is a concern. County roads are in good shape for bicycling Supervisor Veitch are meeting with DOT to figure out what to do at county level. County receptive to this (Keith Manz).
