Meeting Summary

Tuesday, November 28, 2017 at 3:30 pm Saratoga County Planning Office West High Street, Ballston Spa

I. Issues Discussion

- 1. Funding opportunities
 - i. County Trails funding 2019 budget discussion
 - ii. 2018 budget (proposed):
 - 1. \$100,000 open space planning
 - 2. \$50,000 trails
 - iii. Need to work through local supervisors to advocate for 2019 budget
 - iv. Need to make a compelling case for additional funding in 2019
 - 1. Use list developed Katie to build case for additional funding for program
 - 2. Identify strong applications/projects for 2018 program
 - 3. Katie to put together letter for Supervisors to thank them fors for putting resources for trails into the 2018 budget and request additional funding for next budget that does not take away from the open space program
 - 4. Jackie to follow-up with Jason to confirm budget adoption/program funding, eligibility of projects, and schedule.
 - 5. Challenge: communication of available funding goes directly to supervisors and may not always be acted upon as a result of many important issues being handled. Discussions on how to further involve local trail advocates in each community. Another challenge is the limitation on what funding can be used for and the amount that can be requested.

- II. Discussion of Proposed 2018 Goals for the County Board of Supervisors Trail Committee - This list of goals, once consensus is reached by this committee, will be forwarded to the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors Trail Committee for consideration.
 - 1. Zim Smith
 - i. Extend northern terminus: Is the time right for this with the Palermtown planning efforts underqway with Open Space Institute (OSI) and Saratoga PLAN? Jackie to follow-up with Jason.
 - ii. Local Zim Smith Goals:

- 1. City trail near Woods Hollow to connect Milton, Ballston Spa, and Saratoga Springs/future Zim Smith trail
- 2. Segment between Village of Ballston Spa snow dump and County sewer ROW in Malta
- iii. Connecting the Zim Smith to the Champlain Canalway Trail
 - 1. Construct Trail from Coons Crossing to Mechanicville build/construct trail; need to confirm with Jason.
 - 2. Planning for connection from Mechanic ville to CCT need to confirm with Jason on wheter this gets removed as complete or should continue on 2019 goals list.
- 2. Champlain Canalway Projects
 - i. Announcement \$12 million to complete the trail through Waterford and Halfmoon to Rt 4 near the treatment plant just south of Mechanicville; put stone dust on the trail in the Town of Saratoga from near the sword surrender site south to near Garnsey Lane
- 3. Equine trails
 - i. Moreau County Forest and Providence equine trail improvements
 - 1. Providence parking area completed now, but there is a need to complete the trail systems which includes signage, trail marking, and a kiosk. This would complete 9 miles of trails including Ecker Rd.
 - 2. Moreau 2018: complete parking lot; connecting County Forest Land may be a 2019 goal
 - 3. Town of Moreau bike path plan?
- 4. Palmertown regional trail system participation in Master Planning Process
 - i. 1st public meeting for master plan in December
 - Send invite to trails committee: December 13, 5-8:00 Greenfield Community Center. Includes an introduction to the public of the project which is identifying opportunities for the region recreationally and economically. Joint effort with OSI and Saratoga PLAN
 - iii. Lincoln State Forest equine use allowed but trails not developed. Mtn biking, snowmobile corridor, what communities want to be connected: Corinth or Wilton access? How to expand recreational opportunities.
- 5. Blueway Trails -
 - Designation of Kaydeross between Kelley Park and Saratoga Lake as Kaydeross Blueway Trail. It is believed that the next step for this is a resolution for Board of Supervisors vote. Jackie will confirm with Blue Neils.
 - ii. Erie-Mohawk Historic Water Trail Need to be clear about what the ask/need is for this. Jackie to ask Jen Viggiani, Town of Clifton Park.
 - iii. Hudson Blueway Trail along Champlain Canal Need to be clear about what the ask/need is for this. Jackie to ask Jen Viggiani, Town of Clifton Park.
- 6. Hudson Power Express trails opportunities is this still urgent? Project Seems to have been shelved. Remove from 2018 goals.

 - i. Town of Milton is currently conducting due diligience to purchase property
- 2. Corinth trail system It was noted that B. Clarke may have moved so a new contact Jackie to contact Matt Rogers, Corinth Planning Board.
- 3. Linking the towns of Wilton and Northumberland to expand the trail system
- 4. Extend the Ballston Bike Path to Blue Barnes Road the committee discussed asking Scott Miller to present on this to the committee and bring an updated map.
- 5. Local Zim Smith Goals: moved to 2018 County-wide Goals
 - i. City trail near Woods Hollow to connect Milton, B Spa, and Saratoga Springs/future Zim Smith trail
 - ii. Segment between Village of B Spa snow dump and Cty sewer ROW in Malta
- 6. Saratoga Springs Greenbelt system
 - i. Downtown connector

- 8. Upgrades on Rt 32 between Battlefield and Victory Need bike lanes.
- 9. Rt 29 between SS and Schuylerville need bike lanes for entire length
- 10. Jones Road wide enough for bike pedestrian use.
- 11. WWPP needs safe crossing on route 50
- 12. Tunnel/bridge over/under I87 to connect Spring Run Trail to E side of I87
- 13. 146a connector to Ballston Lake Trail
- 14. Crescent Ave Greenbelt Trail section
- 15. Nelson Ave Ext bridge expansion of bike lanes even if by striping

Open Space Institute (OSI) update by Katie:

- January closing on 4,388 acres in Providence and Edinburgh. OSI is purchasing this property along east side of Sacandaga reservoir known as the Hans Creek property. Vly Swamp reservoir included and provides 100% of water supply for City of Amsterdam. Purpose is to protect natural resources, water quality, trails (snowmobile/hiking, etc). Intent is to purchase and sell a conservation easement to allow for public recreation rights and allow to continue to as is or sell in fee to state.
- Smith farm property in Moreau OSI looking to purchase this 900 acre property connecting to Moreau State Park along river and through County Forest Land and National Grid Corridor. Currently delayed due National Grid ROW issue.
